The design for the law offices of Mintz Levin was inspired by a metaphor of Main Street where the shops and café are interpreted into different collaborative spaces including meetings, lunch spaces and study spaces. The layout of the directional carpet pattern, Bentley's Satellite City manufactured with Antron® carpet fiber, became a reference to the orientation of the building. The building

is on a direct axis to the National Archive and Navy Memorial, providing a subtle point of reference without using a map or signage.
